

2. Bring criminal charges against Nikolai Aleksandrovich Lukyanov ("Luka") and Dmitry Georgiyevich Slavov ("Bolgar") to the full extent of martial law for the illegal activities against [REDACTED] that included marauding, discrediting of the military personnel [and the leaders of the National Liberation Movement of the DNR], illegal detention and confinement.
3. The unit of N.A. Lukyanov is to be disbanded and sent to other units.
4. For the low level of control over his subordinates, which led to a serious incident, unit commander "Balu" is to be reprimanded.

**Defender:** "Bolgar" is an excellent soldier, reliable and composed. Before the completion of the mission everyone was notified of consequences. "Bolgar" was not ready for the responsibility placed upon him and proved unable to guide his unit. "Luka" managed to gain "Bolgar's" trust and by means of instigations and innuendos persuaded "Bolgar" to be lenient about commandeering and looting from peaceful citizens. "Bolgar" fell under the influence of "Luka," who misled "Bolgar." "Luka" put "Bolgar" at risk, and "Bolgar" is guilty of poor handling of his duties.
